The language used in each reader is strictly controllled with the grammar syllabus and permitted vocabulary correlating to the CEFR, with a small number of new words being allowed in each story which are all explained in a glossary at the back of the book.

With accompanying audio and additional resources to help test comprehension, grammar and vocabulary skills, Penguin Readers not only help to develop reading, writing and listening, but also critical thinking and twenty-first century skills.





Each Penguin Reader begins with a short introduction and some 'before-reading questions' to help orientate the students towards the subject matter of the story or text.









Comprehension questions directly follow the text and test the students' understanding of each chapter. When students have finished reading the entire book, there is a set of questions to test understanding of the text as a whole.



An exercises section includes grammar-, vocabulary- or comprehension-orientated questions dedicated to most chapters.




At the end of the book, students are given extension work in the form of written projects and in-depth essay questions.
